Under this agreement for 2017 Chatswood Hills State School will receive

\$263,322*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure the percentage of Year 3 and 5 students meeting the National Minimum Standards in reading and numeracy is 95% in 2017 and beyond.
- Maintain the percentage of Year 3 students in the NAPLAN Upper Two Bands in reading above 40%.
- Every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an Individual Curriculum Plan) will achieve a "C" standard or better against the relevant year level achievement standard.

Our initiatives include

- Creating a Chatty Readers Team and upskilling members to further enhance and track student progress and improvement in reading.
- Provide further Professional Development and Coaching to teachers and teacher aides in the areas of Reading, Numeracy and Curriculum alignment and purchase resources to support this.
- Provide additional support and training for teacher aides to assist with the delivery of an oral language program in early years.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Focusing teacher aide support in P-6 to enhance guided reading and numeracy outcomes. \$ 62 400
- Maintaining the Literacy Enhancement Program to support students in Years 1-3. \$ 47 000
- Employing additional Pedagogical, Curriculum, Literacy and Numeracy coaching time to build teacher capacity to analyse data and deliver targeted and explicit teaching in the literacy and numeracy areas. \$ 45 530
- Providing additional TRS to enable Professional Learning Team time to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, planning, classroom visits and professional conversations. \$108 392
